BY-LAW No. 759-2009

**To amend By-law No. 196-84 of the former City of York, being a By-law
“To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”, regarding Elsmere Avenue.**

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That Schedule VIII (No Parking) of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by deleting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Side</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Prohibited</u> <u>Times or Days</u>
Elsmere Avenue	North and South	Weston Road and the easterly terminus of the street	Anytime

2. That Schedule XI (No Standing) of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Side</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Prohibited</u> <u>Times or Days</u>
Elsmere Avenue	Both	Weston Road and the easterly terminus of Elsmere Avenue	Anytime
