

Authority Etobicoke York Community Council Item 29.29, as adopted by Etobicoke York Community Council on September 15, 2009 under the delegated authority of Sections 27-149B and 27-152 of Chapter 27, Council Procedures, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code

Enacted by Etobicoke York Community Council: September 15, 2009

CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 769-2009

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Ascot Avenue, Bristol Avenue, Deforest Road and Earlscourt Avenue.

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Ascot Avenue	South	A point 37.2 metres west of Boon Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
Deforest Road	South	A point 27.5 metres east of Windermere Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime
Earlscourt Avenue	East	A point 119 metres south of Hope Street and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
Earlscourt Avenue	West	A point 119 metres south of Hope Street and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Bristol Avenue	West	A point 171.3 metres north of Geary Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime

Deforest Road	South	A point 55 metres east of Windermere Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime
