BY-LAW No. 777-2009

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Ridelle Avenue.

The North York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, of the City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Ridelle Avenue	South	A point 88.5 metres west of Locksley Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
