BY-LAW No. 822-2009

To name the public lane extending easterly from St. Nicholas Street, then southerly to Irwin Avenue, as “Cottage Lane”.

WHEREAS City of Toronto Council has delegated the legislative authority for local routine matters, such as the naming of public lanes, to Community Councils by adopting Executive Committee Item 2.5, as amended, at its meeting held on February 5, 6, 7 and 8, 2007; and

WHEREAS pursuant to § 27-152E(5) of Chapter 27, Council Procedures, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, Toronto and East York Community Council has the authority to pass a by-law naming the public lane;

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land comprised of the public lane extending easterly from St. Nicholas Street, then southerly to Irwin Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 21109-0116 (R)

The Lane on Plan 218E, parts of Lots 8, 9, 10 and 11 on Plan D-3 designated as PART 5 on Plan 63R-528, parts of Lots 11 and 12 on Plan D-3 designated as PART 1 on Plan 63R-2728 and parts of Lots 5 and 6 on Plan 218E designated as PART 2 on Plan 64R-13118

City of Toronto and Province of Ontario
Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is named as “Cottage Lane”.
