BY-LAW No. 850-2009

To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic of former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Lake Shore Boulevard West and Remembrance Drive.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Lake Shore Boulevard and Ontario Drive (M.T. 2)	Westbound	Left	Anytime
Remembrance Drive at Lake Shore Boulevard approximately 270 Metres west of Newfoundland Road (M.T. 2)	Eastbound	Left	Anytime
Remembrance Drive eastbound exit from Lake Shore Boulevard to Ontario Place Parking at Ontario Place Extension of Ontario Drive	Eastbound	Left	Anytime
