**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 889-2009**

**To pass an Interim Control By-law affecting those lands in the Consumers Employment Area generally bounded by Sheppard Avenue East to the north, Victoria Park Avenue to the east, Highway 401 to the south and Highway 404 to the west.**

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto has, by adopting Motion MM40.11 at its meeting of September 30 and October 1, 2009, directed that a review be undertaken of the regulations pertaining to places of worship in the Consumers Employment Area; and

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 38 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass an Interim Control By-law for a period of time which shall not exceed one year from the date of passage of the By-law for such purposes as are set out in the By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

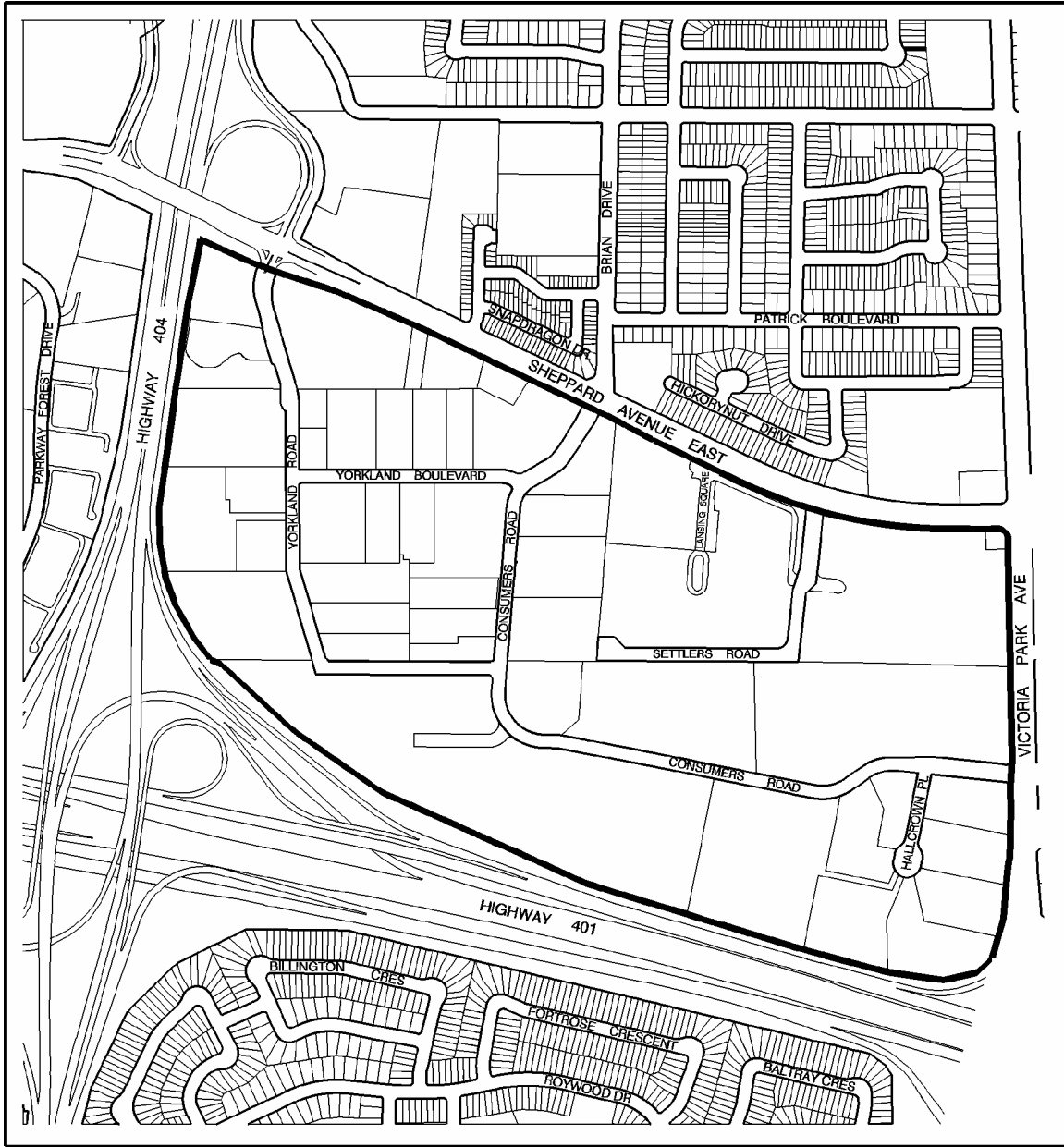
1. Places of worship are prohibited on any lands shown within the heavy lines on Schedule 1 attached to this By-law.
2. This By-law expires one year from the date of its enactment by Council.
