BY-LAW No. 897-2009

To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Bathurst Street, Fairlawn Avenue and Prince Charles Drive.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Between a point 10 metres north of the north curb line of Prince Charles Drive and a point 30.5 metres south of the south curb line of Prince Charles Drive
