BY-LAW No. 906-2009

To permanently close a below-grade portion of Bremner Boulevard.

WHEREAS it is recommended that a below-grade portion of Bremner Boulevard be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in Toronto and East York Community Council Item 24.102, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on April 6, 2009; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the portion of the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting held on September 15, 2009;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The below-grade portion of Bremner Boulevard, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of PIN 21396-0002 (LT)
Part of Block 1, Plan 655E
Part of Lorne Street, Plan 536E, amended by Plan 642E
Designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-24314
