BY-LAW No. 1014-2009

To amend By-law No. 2958-94 of the former City of York, being a By-law “To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”, regarding Belgravia Avenue and Whitmore Avenue.

The North York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That Schedule XII (One-Way Streets) of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by deleting from Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

Whitmore Avenue	Dufferin Street and Marlee Avenue	Anytime	Eastbound

2. That Schedule XII (One-Way Streets) of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Whitmore Avenue	A point 40 metres east of Dufferin Street and Marlee Avenue	Anytime	Eastbound

3. That Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Belgravia Avenue and driveway access to Premises No. 2401 Dufferin Street (Rexall Pharma Plus)	Westbound	Right	Anytime
