BY-LAW No. 1026-2009

To authorize alteration of the roadway on Corley Avenue, between Woodbine Avenue and Brookside Drive, by the removal of traffic islands and by the installation of speed humps.

WHEREAS a speed hump poll of households on Corley Avenue, between Woodbine Avenue and Brookside Drive, was conducted and as the results were favourable pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, it is appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Corley Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alterations are authorized:

The construction of speed humps and the removal of traffic islands on Corley Avenue, between Woodbine Avenue and Brookside Drive, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-9634 dated April 2009, on file in the offices of Transportation Services.
