BY-LAW No. 1038-2009

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Dundas Street East and Inwood Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, of the City of Toronto is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Dundas Street East	South	A point 51.5 metres east of Leslie Street and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime
Inwood Avenue	East	A point 113 metres north of Milverton Boulevard and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime during the months of May, July, Sept. and Nov.
Inwood Avenue	West	A point 110.5 metres north of Milverton Boulevard and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime during the months of Jan., Feb., Mar., Apr., June, Aug., Oct. and Dec.
