BY-LAW No. 1076-2009

**To permanently close to vehicular traffic, a portion of the public highway Lake Shore
Boulevard East between Woodfield Road and Knox Avenue.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard East between Woodfield Road and Knox Avenue be permanently closed to vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS the said portion of highway abuts on land owned by the Crown in right of Canada and, in accordance with the provisions of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, the consent to the closure was obtained from the Government of Canada; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting held on October 13, 2009;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. A portion of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard East, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed to vehicular traffic:

Part of the 150 Foot Wide Road on Plan 159E designated as Part 1 on
Plan 66R-24032
City of Toronto and Province of Ontario,
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)
