BY-LAW No. 1100-2009

**To amend By-law No. 45-84 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto,
respecting the regulation of traffic in Exhibition Place, to update the general offence
provision in the by-law.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 45-84 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, respecting the regulation of traffic in Exhibition Place, is hereby amended by deleting section 11 and substituting the following:

- “11. (1) Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law, other than section 6, resulting from the operation of a motor vehicle, is guilty of an offence.
- (2) Any person who contravenes the provision contained in section 6 of this bylaw, resulting from the operation of a motor vehicle, is guilty of an offence under the *Highway Traffic Act*.
- (3) Where a motor vehicle has been left parked, stopped or standing in contravention of this by-law, the owner of the motor vehicle at the time of the contravention is guilty of an offence and is liable to the fine prescribed for the offence unless, at the time of the offence, the motor vehicle was in the possession of some person other than the owner without the owner’s consent.”
