1. Schedule "A" to By-law No. 62-91, being a By-law "To provide reserved lanes for bicycles on certain Metropolitan Roads", as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:
