BY-LAW No. 1115-2010

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways,
Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, respecting bicycle lanes on Lansdowne Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street names:

| Lansdowne Avenue | Wallace Avenue and a point 102.5 metres south of Lappin Avenue | Northbound lane adjacent to the curb lane used for parking | Anytime |

| Lansdowne Avenue | Lappin Avenue and a point 42.5 metres south of Dupont Street | Northbound lane adjacent of the curb lane used for parking | Anytime |
| Lansdowne Avenue | A point 46 metres north of Bloor Street West and Wade Avenue | Westerly Southbound | Anytime |
| Lansdowne Avenue | Wade Avenue and Paton Road | Southbound lane adjacent to the curb lane used for parking | Anytime |

| Lansdowne Avenue | Lappin Avenue and a point 42.5 metres south of Dupont Street | Westerly Southbound | Anytime |
