 - (i) realigning of the centre of the road three metres to the west between North Queen Street and a point 36 metres further north, and then tapering 26 metres back eastwards to the existing centre of Index Road;
 - (ii) building a sidewalk on the west side of the road;generally as shown on the drawings attached to this By-law.

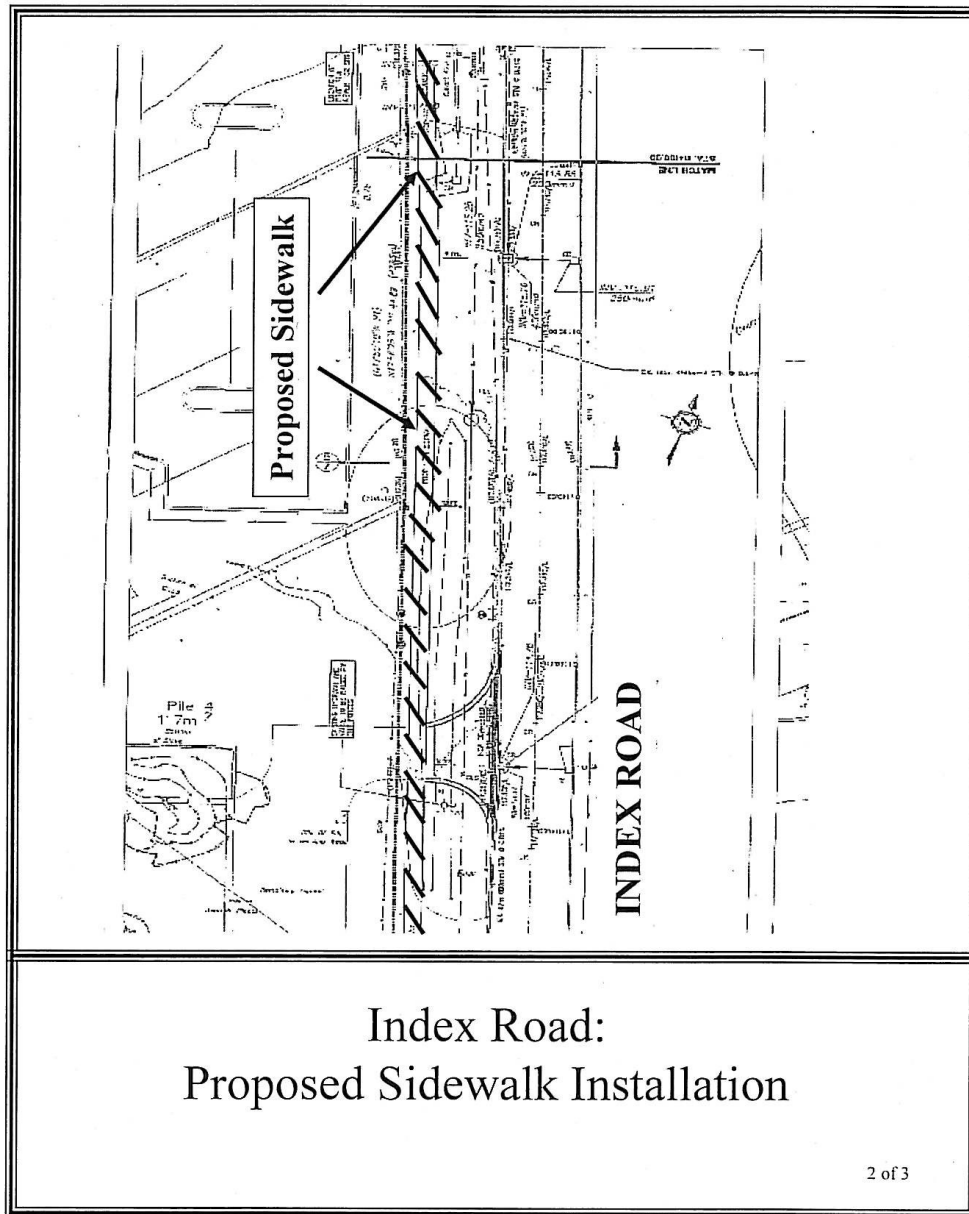

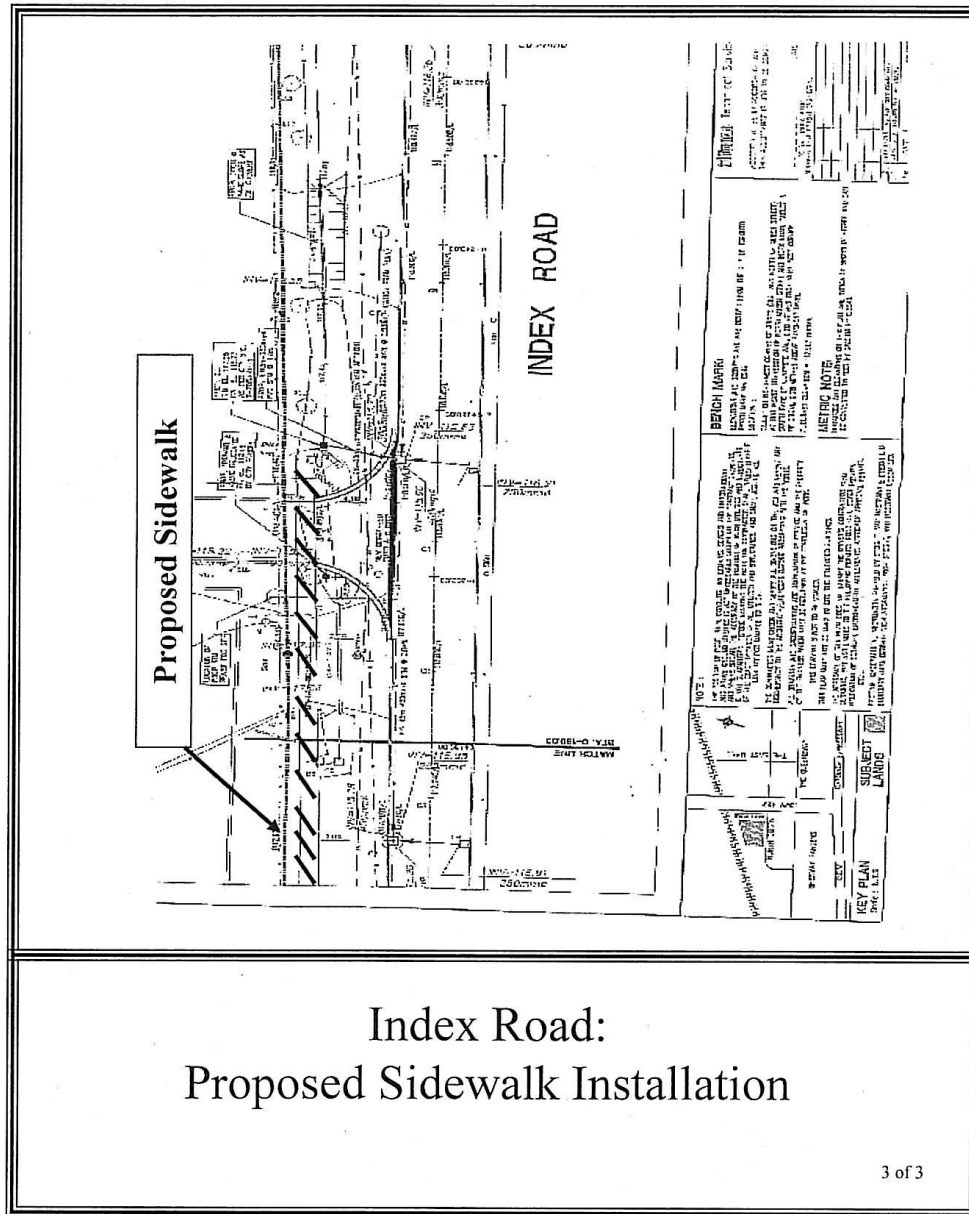

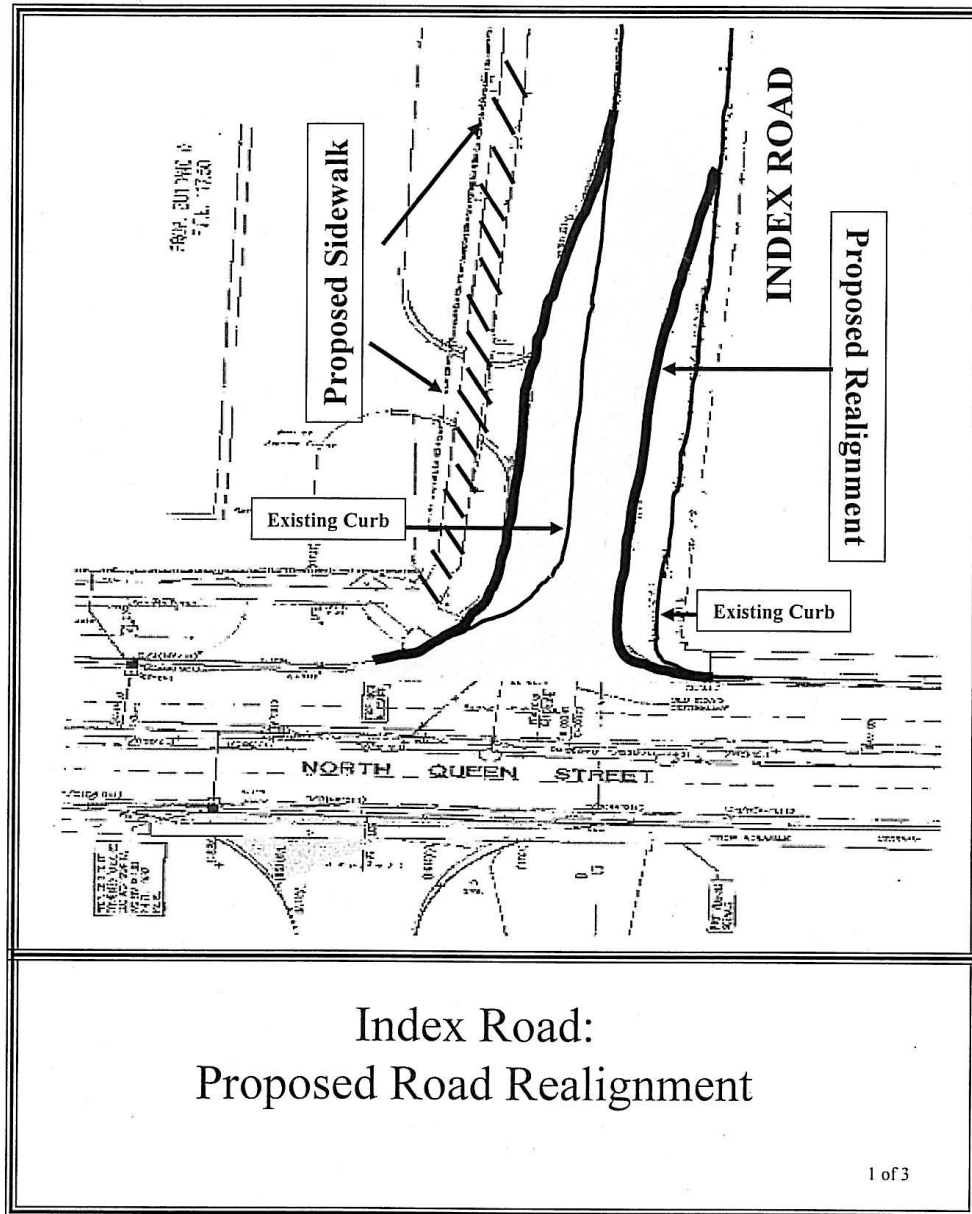

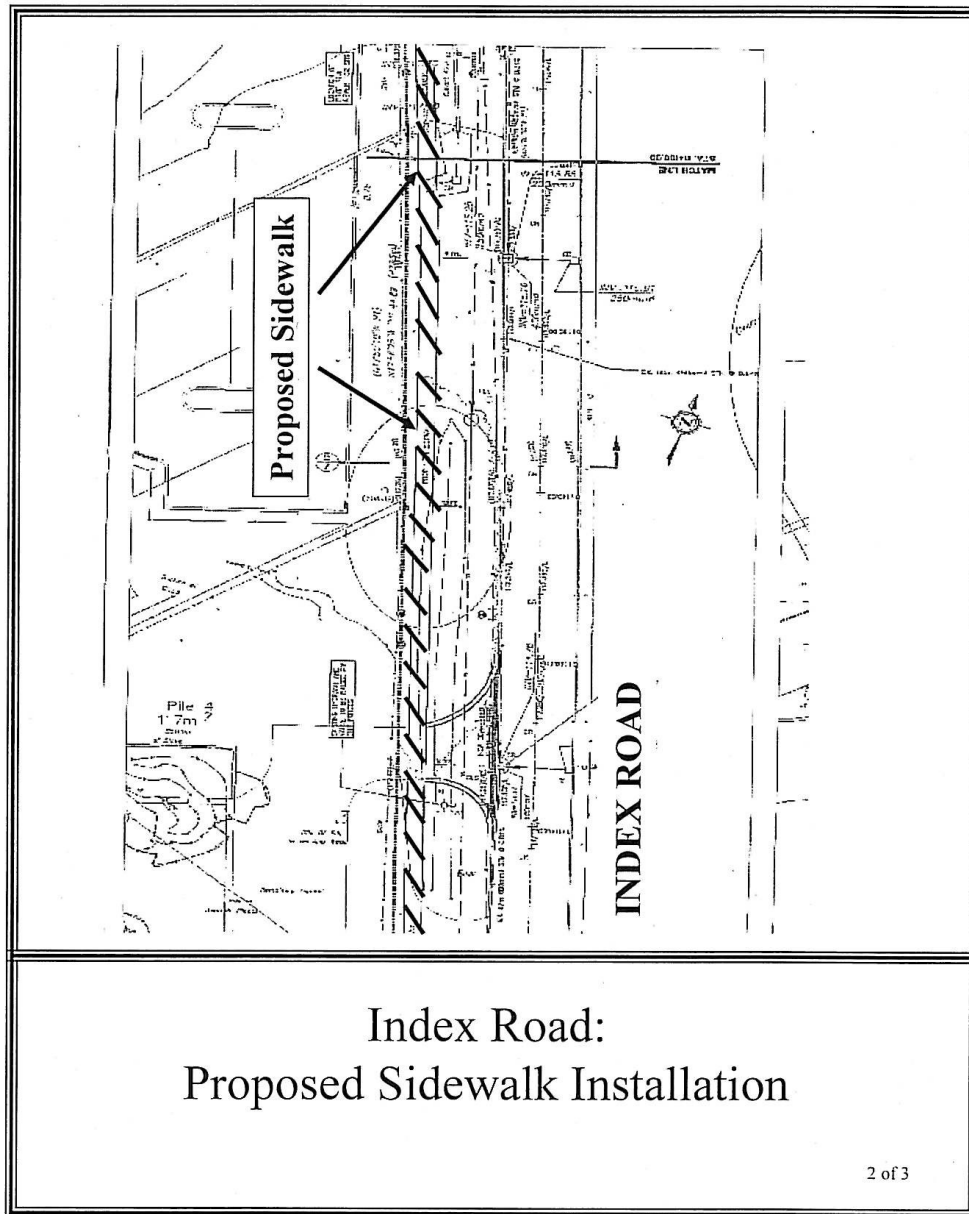
