BY-LAW No. 107-2011

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, to make changes to the size of various Business Improvement Area Boards of Management.

WHEREAS Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code designates various areas of the City as Business Improvement Areas; and

WHEREAS Scarborough Community Council, under delegated authority, has approved the removal of some members from some Boards of Management, and the appointment of members to various Business Improvement Area Boards of Management, for a term expiring on November 30, 2014, or as soon thereafter as successors are appointed; and

WHEREAS Schedule A of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, must be amended to reflect the change in the number of members and the number required for quorum of the various Business Improvement Area Boards of Management;

The Scarborough Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The table in Schedule A of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, is amended as follows:
 - (1) by changing the number of members of the Kennedy Road Business Improvement Area Board of Management to 12 and the number required for quorum to 5;
 - (2) by changing the number of members of the Wexford Heights Business Improvement Area Board of Management to 21 and the number required for quorum to 10;
 - (3) by changing the number of members of the Sheppard East Village Business Improvement Area Board of Management to 10; and
 - (4) by changing the number of members of the Crossroads of the Danforth Business Improvement Area Board of Management to 8.
