CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 158-2011

To dedicate certain land on the east side of Conlins Road, north of Military Trail for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Conlins Road.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired for highway widening purposes by a transfer registered as A259385 in 1969. In order to legalize access to 25 Conlins Road this land must be dedicated by by-law for public highway purposes;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 06234-0037 (LT)
PT LT G, PL M562, PT 1 66R3809

City of Toronto (former City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the highway Conlins Road.
