

CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 233-2011

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 918, Parking on Residential Front Yards and Boulevards, to refer to a system of accessible parking, accessible parking permits and persons with a disability, as amended by By-law No. 1154-2010.

WHEREAS on August 27, 2010, Council passed By-law No. 1154-2010, being a by-law "To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, Chapter 150, Municipal Law Enforcement Officers, Chapter 608, Parks, Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, Chapter 915, Parking on Private or Municipal Property, Chapter 918, Parking on Residential Front Yards and Boulevards, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, former Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 85-90, being a by-law "To authorize certain on-street parking of vehicles operated by or for physically disabled persons", former City of Scarborough By-law No. 23059, being a by-law "To authorize certain on-street parking of vehicles operated by or for disabled persons", former City of Scarborough By-law No. 24032, being a by-law "To regulate parking for disabled person parking permit holders", former Borough of East York By-law No. 34-93, being a by-law "To provide for disabled person parking permit holders", former Borough of East York By-law No. 122-93, being a by-law "To licence and regulate boulevard parking in residential areas", former City of North York By-law No. 31770, being a by-law "To regulate parking for disabled person parking permit holders", former City of York Municipal Code Chapter 965, Parking-Disabled-Off-Street, former City of York Municipal Code Chapter 966, Parking-Disabled-Off-Street, former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code Chapter 183, Parking, and former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code Chapter 240, Traffic, to refer a System of Accessible Parking, Accessible Parking Permits and Persons with a Disability"; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 1154-2010 has not yet come into force; and

WHEREAS the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsections 6H, 6I and 6J of By-law No. 1154-2010 are each amended by deleting the phrase: "Section 918-18" and inserting in lieu thereof the phrase: "Section 918-19".
2. Subsection 6K of By-law No. 1154-2010 is amended by deleting the phrase: "Section 918-21" and inserting in lieu thereof the phrase: "Section 918-20".

3. Section 1 and 2 of this by-law come into force on the day that By-law No. 1154-2010 comes into force as set out in section 19 of By-law No. 1154-2010 as follows:

"19. This by-law shall come into force 30 days after the date of approval by the Regional Senior Justice of the set fines required for the new or amended offences created by this by-law."
