BY-LAW No. 315-2011

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Chisholm Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Chisholm Avenue	East	A point 6 metres south of Gates Avenue and a point 11 metres further south	5:30 p.m. of one day to 5:30 a.m. of the next following day, Mon. to Fri.; and anytime Sat. and Sun.

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXIX (Designated On-Street Loading Zones for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-92, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Chisholm Avenue	East	A point 6 metres south of Gates Avenue	A point 11 metres further south	5:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Mon. to Fri.
