## **CITY OF TORONTO**

## BY-LAW No. 517-2011

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, respecting the licensing of business establishments in hotels.

WHEREAS the *City of Toronto Act*, 2006 grants the City of Toronto the authority to enact by-laws for the licensing, regulating and governing of businesses wholly or partly carried on in the City of Toronto; and

WHEREAS, as the result of changes in provincial legislation, the City of Toronto has the jurisdiction to licence business establishments located in hotels where previously such businesses were exempted; and

WHEREAS the licensing of business establishments located in hotels is desireable in the interests of consumer protection and public health and safety;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

The City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, is amended by:

- 1. Deleting the articles listed in Column 1 of the attached Schedule A and replacing each of them with the corresponding article listed in Column 2 of Schedule A.
- **2.** This by-law comes into effect upon its enactment.
