1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Boon Avenue	East	A point 45.6 metres south of Teignmouth Avenue and a point 6 metres north thereof	from the 1st day of each month to the 15th day of each month, April 1st to November 30th, inclusive
Boon Avenue	East	A point 45.6 metres south of Teignmouth Avenue and a point 6 metres north thereof	Anytime, from the 1st day of December to the 31st day of March, inclusive

2. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Dynevor Road	East	A point 47 metres north of Hunter Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
