CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 598-2011

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Dockside Drive and Knapp Lane.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Dockside Drive (east-west portion)	South	A point 14 metres east of the north-south portion of Dockside Drive and a point 18.5 metres further east	Anytime
Dockside Drive (east-west portion)	South	A point 97 metres east of the north-south portion of Dockside Drive and Knapp Lane	Anytime
Dockside Drive (north-south portion)	West	Queens Quay East and a point 51 metres south	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XXIV (No Stopping) in § 400-77, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Dockside Drive	East and north	Queens Quay East and Knapp Lane	Anytime
Knapp Lane	Both	Queens Quay East and Dockside Drive	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XXIX (No Standing) in § 400-82, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Dockside Drive (east-west portion)	South	A point 47.5 metres east of the north-south portion of Dockside Drive and a point 24 metres further east	Anytime
Dockside Drive	West and South	A point 51 metres south of Queens Quay East and a point 14 metres east of the north-south portion of Dockside Drive	Anytime

2. As permitted by section 37 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, the enactment of this by-law shall not be deemed to be an assumption by the City of the public highways Dockside Drive and Knapp Lane so as to render the City liable for the repair or for any damages resulting from non-repair within the meaning of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, section 42; nor shall the enactment of this by-law be deemed to be an assumption by the City of those public highways.
