**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 665-2011**

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,  
respecting King Street East.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

- A.** By deleting from Schedule XXIV (No Stopping) in § 400-77, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
King Street East	North	Yonge Street and Parliament Street	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

- B.** By inserting in Schedule XXIV (No Stopping) in § 400-77, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
King Street East	North	Parliament Street and a point 68.5 metres west	Anytime
King Street East	North	Yonge Street and a point 68.5 metres west of Parliament Street	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

C. By deleting from Schedule XXV (Time Limit Parking) in § 400-78, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)	(From Column 5)
King Street East	North	A point 20.2 metres west of Frederick Street and a point 30.5 metres west of Parliament Street	9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.; 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Sat.	2 hours

2. This By-law shall be effective commencing May 17, 2011.
