## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW No. 702-2011**

#### **To amend the Municipal Code of the former City of Etobicoke with respect to Traffic - Chapter 240, Article I, regarding Lanor Avenue and Bellman Avenue.**

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 240, Article I, of the Municipal Code of the former City of Etobicoke is hereby amended by the deletion from and addition to the street or portions thereof and regulations under the headings set out herein and therein as follows:

- (a) deletion(s) to SCHEDULE XVIII – Through Highways

Column 1 Road	Column 2 Between
Lanor Avenue	The east limit of the road and the east limit of 30th Street

- (b) addition(s) to SCHEDULE XVIII – Through Highways

Column 1 Road	Column 2 Between
Lanor Avenue	The west limit of Bellman Avenue and the east limit of Thirtieth Street

- (c) addition(s) to SCHEDULE XIX – Stop Signs

Column 1 Intersection	Column 2 Stop Street
Lanor Avenue and Bellman Avenue	Lanor Avenue, east of Bellman Avenue Lanor Avenue, west of Bellman Avenue Bellman Avenue, north of Lanor Avenue Bellman Avenue, south of Lanor Avenue
