BY-LAW No. 770-2011

To permanently close a portion of the public highway at rear of 222 Combe Avenue.

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public highway at the rear of 222 Combe Avenue be permanently closed as a public highway; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of the public highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the North York Community Council and no one appeared to address the North York Community Council at its meeting held on April 21, 2011;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public highway at rear of 222 Combe Avenue, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of Tillplain Road (formerly Kipling Street), Plan 1899, City of Toronto,
designated as Part 1 on Reference Plan 66R-25327, City of Toronto
