BY-LAW No. 840-2011

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Melrose Avenue.

The North York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Melrose Avenue	South	A point 88.5 metres east of Greer Road and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime
