BY-LAW No. 859-2011

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law "To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York", being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding Barker Avenue and Cedarvale Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XVIII (Through Streets) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Road)

(From Column 2
Between)

Cedarvale Avenue

Cosburn Avenue and Lumsden Avenue

2. Schedule XVIII (Through Streets) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words opposite each other in alphabetical order by road name, in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

The north side of Lumsden Avenue and the south side of Barker Avenue

The north side of Barker Avenue and the south side of Cosburn Avenue

3. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words opposite each other in alphabetical order by intersection name, in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:
