CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 892-2011

To appoint John W. Livey as a Deputy City Manager.

WHEREAS under section 140 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, the City may appoint a chief administrative officer; and

WHEREAS under section 77 of the Legislation Act, the power to appoint a person to a public office includes the power to appoint a deputy; and

WHEREAS under section 67 of the Legislation Act, words in the singular include the plural; and

WHEREAS Council has approved an administrative structure in which the City's chief administrative officer is called the "City Manager" and is to be assisted by two Deputy City Managers and a Deputy City Manager and Chief Financial Officer;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. John W. Livey is appointed to the office of Deputy City Manager (Planning and Public Works) and shall have all the powers conferred and duties of the City Manager under Article I of Chapter 169, Officials, City, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code as may be assigned by the City Manager from time to time.
- 2. City of Toronto By-law No. 146-2007, "To appoint Richard Butts as Deputy City Manager", is repealed.
- **3.** This by-law comes into force on August 2, 2011.
