BY-LAW No. 941-2011

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths,
Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, regarding bicycle lanes on Dupont Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting in alphabetical order from the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A the following:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)
Dupont Street	North, adjacent to curb	Symington Avenue and a point 40 metres east of Lansdowne Avenue
Dupont Street	South, adjacent to curb	Campbell Avenue and a point 40 metres east of Lansdowne Avenue

B. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Dupont Street	North, adjacent to curb	Symington Avenue and a point 70 metres west of Lansdowne Avenue
Dupont Street	South, adjacent to curb	Campbell Avenue and a point 70 metres west of Lansdowne Avenue
