CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 958-2011

To repeal By-law No. 767-2011, being a by-law "To permanently close the public highway described as being the untravelled New Crescent between 697 and 699 Danforth Road on Plan 1776, save and except SC101937 and SC84473, and shown as Part 1 on Sketch No. PS-2003-100 (the "Highway"))".

WHEREAS By-law No. 767-2011 was enacted by City of Toronto Council on June 15, 2011 and through an error contained an inaccurate legal description, resulting in a by-law that could not be registered on title, as required; and

WHEREAS the City Solicitor is authorized under § 169-26A to submit bills where it is necessary to repeal a by-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 767-2011, being a by-law "To permanently close the public highway described as being the untravelled New Crescent between 697 and 699 Danforth Road on plan 1776, save and except SC101937 and SC84473, and shown as Part 1 on Sketch No. PS-2003-100 (the "Highway"))", is repealed.
