## BY-LAW No. 988-2011

- A. By deleting from Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

B. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Rogers Road	A point 37 metres west of Bronoco Avenue and Gilbert Avenue	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
