BY-LAW No. 1155-2011

To amend By-law No. 1048-2007, being a by-law "To permanently close a portion of the public highway Oakburn Place, branching southerly from the south side of Oakburn Crescent".

WHEREAS it is recommended that By-law No. 1048-2007, being a by-law to permanently close a portion of the public highway Oakburn Place, branching southerly from the south side of Oakburn Crescent, be amended;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** By-law No. 1048-2007 is hereby amended by deleting Section 2 therefrom and replacing it with the following new Section 2:
 - 2. (a) Section 1 of this By-law does not come into effect with respect to that portion of the lands designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-25308 until the land described as follows is transferred to the City of Toronto and dedicated as a public highway, after being designed and constructed for public highway purposes and deemed acceptable for public use by the City of Toronto's General Manager, Transportation Services Division:

Part of PIN 10104-1606 (LT) Part of Lots 16, 17, 18 and 19, Plan 4460, City of Toronto, designated as Part 2 on Plan 66R-25101

(b) Section 1 of this By-law does not come into effect with respect to that portion of the lands designated as Part 2 on Plan 66R-25308 until the moment in time immediately prior to the registration in the appropriate land registry office of a Transfer, by the City of Toronto as transferor, of the lands designated as Part 2 on Plan 66R-25308.
