**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1356-2011**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, to  
reflect the expanded boundaries of the Cabbagetown Business Improvement Area.**

WHEREAS Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas of The City of Toronto Municipal Code designates various areas of the City as Business Improvement Areas, including the Cabbagetown Business Improvement Area; and

WHEREAS by the enactment of By-law No. 1355-2011 on December 1, 2011, City of Toronto Council designated an area that includes the existing Cabbagetown Business Improvement Area (as described in By-law No. 1-82 of the former City of Toronto) as an improvement area; and

WHEREAS Schedule A of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas must be amended to reflect the designation of the expanded Cabbagetown Business Improvement Area;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, is amended as follows:
  - A. The table in Schedule A of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, is amended by deleting By-law No. "1-82 (Toronto)" beside the name "Cabbagetown (formerly Old Cabbagetown)" in the "Designating By-law (Former Municipality)" column and substituting "1355-2011"; and
  - B. Schedule A, Maps is amended by deleting the map of the Cabbagetown Business Improvement Area and substituting the Map of the Cabbagetown Business Improvement Area attached to this by-law.

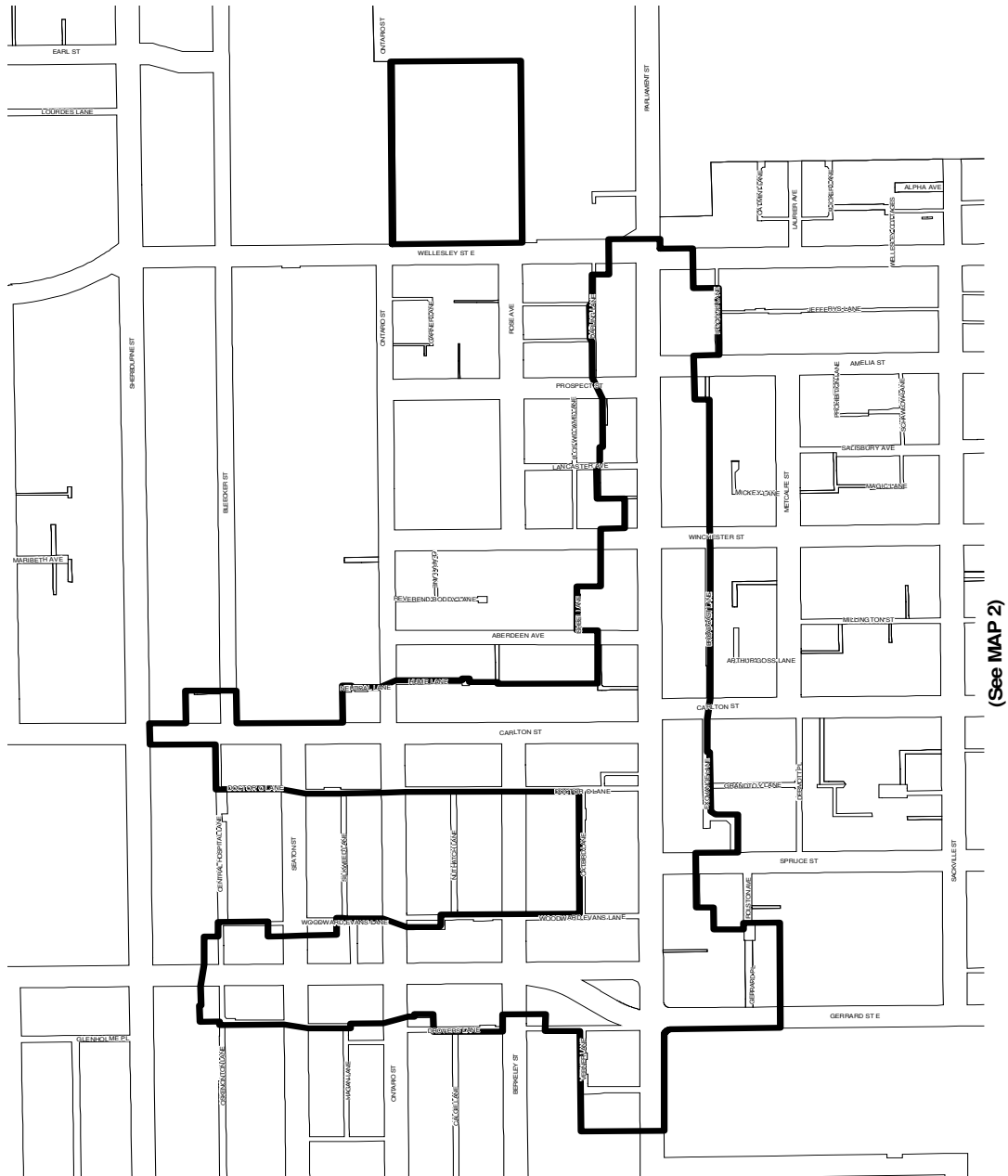
