**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1001-2012**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways,  
Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, respecting bicycle lanes on Annette Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Annette Street	Durie Street and a point 50 metres east of Runnymede Road	Northerly Westbound	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Annette Street	Durie Street and a point 37 metres east of Runnymede Road	Northerly Westbound	Anytime
