BY-LAW No. 1039-2012

To amend By-law No. 32-95 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, "To establish removal zones and regulate vending on Metro roads", to expand the types of foods which may be sold from a vending display unit.

WHEREAS City Council, after consideration of the report (June 14, 2012) from the Executive Director, Municipal Licensing and Standards, has decided to permit street food vendors to expand their menu choices, subject to compliance with existing by-laws and the approval of the Medical Officer of Health;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 32-95 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, "To establish removal zones and regulate vending on Metro roads", is amended by deleting section 6.1 and substituting the following:
 - 6.1 No person shall sell, offer, display or expose for sale any foodstuffs or refreshments from a vending display unit except those permitted under Ontario Regulation 562 made under the Health Protection and Promotion Act, subject to compliance with the requirements of this by-law and the approval of the Medical Officer of Health.
