CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 1041-2012

To amend former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 315, Street Vending, to expand the types of foods which may be sold from a portable display unit.

WHEREAS City Council, after consideration of the report (June 14, 2012) from the Executive Director, Municipal Licensing and Standards, has decided to permit street food vendors to expand their menu choices, subject to compliance with existing by-laws and the approval of the Medical Officer of Health;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 315, Street Vending, of the Municipal Code of the former City of Toronto is amended by deleting § 313-19.1 and substituting the following:

§ 315-19.1 Permitted food items.

No person shall vend any food items from a portable display unit other than those permitted under Ontario Regulation 562 made under the Health Protection and Promotion Act, subject to compliance with the requirements of this chapter and the approval of the Medical Officer of Health.
