BY-LAW No. 1293-2012

To amend former Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 62-91 respecting reserved lanes for bicycles on certain Metropolitan Roads, regarding Jarvis Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule "A" to By-law No. 62-91, being a By-law "To provide reserved lanes for bicycles on certain Metropolitan Roads", as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Lanes)	(From Column 4 Times or Days)
Jarvis Street	Queen Street East and a point 50 metres north of Maitland Place	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Jarvis Street	A point 50 metres north of Maitland Place and a point 22 metres further north	Northbound lane adjacent to lay-by	Anytime
Jarvis Street	A point 77 metres north of Maitland Place and Isabella Street	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Jarvis Street	Queen Street East and Charles Street East	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
