BY-LAW No. 1295-2012

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways,
Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting bicycle lanes on Jarvis Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Lanes)	(From Column 4 Times or Days)
Jarvis Street	Queen Street East and a point 50 metres north of Maitland Place	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Jarvis Street	A point 50 metres north of Maitland Place and a point 22 metres further north	Northbound lane adjacent to lay-by	Anytime
Jarvis Street	A point 77 metres north of Maitland Place and Isabella Street	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Jarvis Street	Queen Street East and Charles Street East	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
