## BY-LAW No. 9-2013

## To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Black Creek Drive.

Whereas the May 19, 2009 Staff Report considered by Etobicoke York Community Council on June 9, 2009 (Item EY28.39) recommended as Recommendation 3 that a "Pedestrians Prohibited on Certain Highways" regulation be enacted on the east side of Black Creek Drive from the southerly limit of Eglinton Avenue West to 175 metres to the south; and

Whereas Etobicoke York Community Council at its meeting on June 9, 2009, adopted as amended, the Staff Report, including Recommendation 3; and

Whereas Etobicoke York Community Council enacted By-law No. 634-2009 on June 9, 2009 in connection with the above-noted Item, rescinding the pedestrian prohibition on both sides of Black Creek Drive and inadvertently re-enacting the pedestrian prohibition on both sides of the subject portion of Black Creek Drive instead of on the east side only; and

Whereas under Section 169-26 of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to make technical amendments to The City of Toronto Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

- 1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, of the City of Toronto is hereby amended as follows:
- A. By deleting from Schedule II (Pedestrians Prohibited on Certain Highways) in § 950-1301, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

B. By inserting in Schedule II (Pedestrians Prohibited on Certain Highways) in § 950-1301, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Black Creek Drive, east side (northbound)

Eglinton Avenue West and a point 175 metres south
