BY-LAW No. 129-2013

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Morse Street.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times or Days)
Morse Street	East	A point 45.7 metres south of Queen Street East and a point 126.5 metres further south	8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.

- B. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times or Days)
Morse Street	East	A point 47 metres south of Queen Street East and a point 32 metres further south	8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri.
Morse Street	East	A point 79 metres south of Queen Street East and a point 104 metres further south	8:30 a.m. to 8:40 a.m., 9:15 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and from 3:45 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri.

C. By inserting in Schedule XXV (Time Limit Parking) in § 400-78, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Morse Street	East	A point 79 metres south of Queen Street East and a point 104 metres further south	8:40 a.m. to 9:15 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 3:45 p.m. Mon. to Fri.	15 mins.
