## BY-LAW No. 151-2013

## To designate part of the public highway Simcoe Street north of Queen Street West as a pedestrian walkway.

Whereas the Council of the former Corporation of the City of Toronto approved the dedication of a part of the highway Simcoe Street north of Queen Street West principally as a way for the use of pedestrians; and

Whereas such approval was made subject to the approval of the Minister of Transportation, Ontario ("MTO") as such approval was required under the prevailing legislation; and

Whereas as a result of legislative changes MTO approval is no longer required; and

Whereas it is recommended that a portion of Simcoe Street be established as a way for the use of pedestrians;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Part of the public highway Simcoe Street described as follows, be established as a way for the use of pedestrians:

Part of PIN 21207-0132 (LT) Part of William Street on Plan 1-49-55 (known as Simcoe Street) designated as PARTS 11 and 12 on Plan 64R-15600
