Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) City of Toronto and Province of Ontario

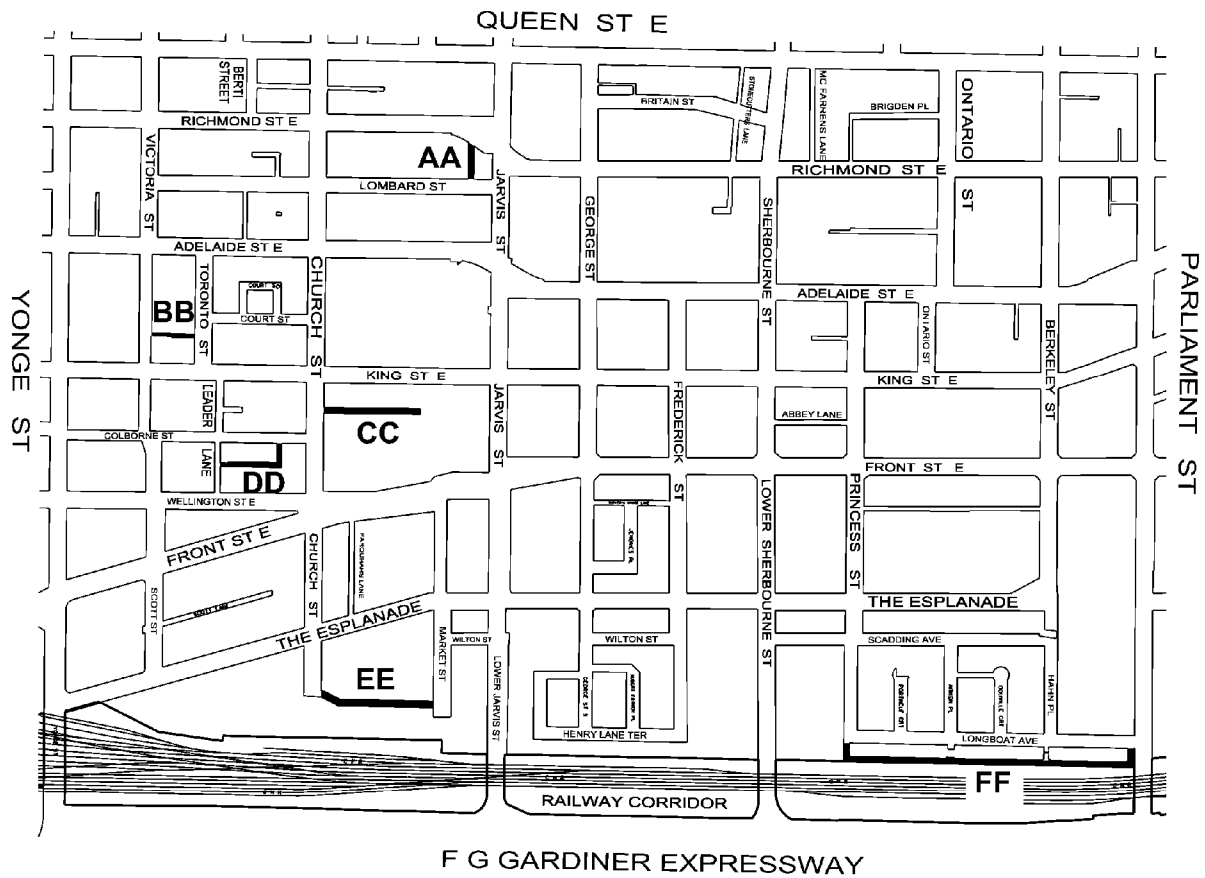
and shown on the sketch attached to this By-law is named "Old Post Office Lane".
