City of Toronto and Province of Ontario

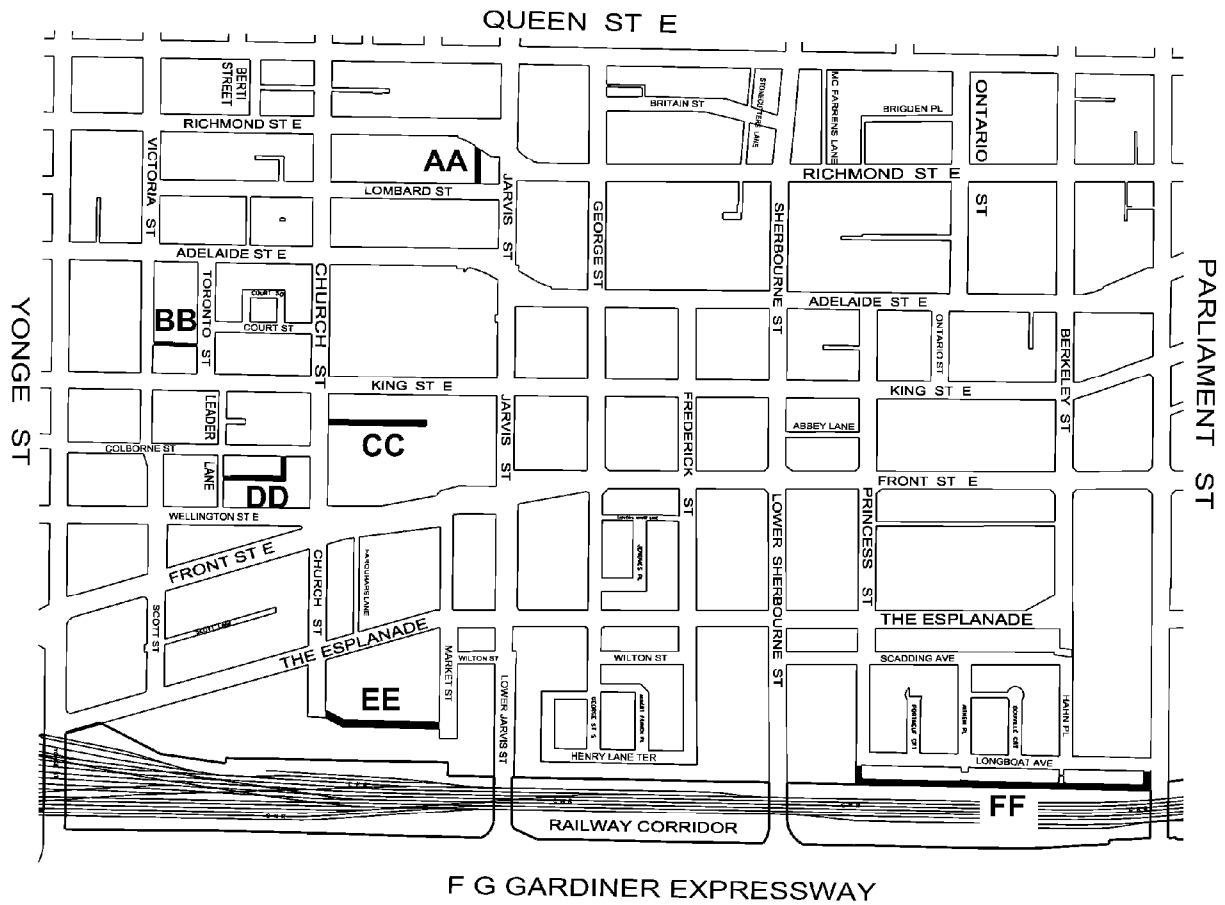
and shown on the sketch attached to this By-law is named "Oak Hall Lane".
