BY-LAW No. 369-2013

To amend further By-law No. 34-93, a by-law "To provide for disabled person parking permit holders", being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding Linsmore Crescent.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Schedule 'E' (Designated On-Street Parking for the Disabled) of By-law No. 34-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Linsmore Crescent	East	A point 10 metres south of Queensdale Avenue and a point 15.5 metres south of Queensdale Avenue	During the months of Jan., Feb., Mar., Apr., Jun., Aug., Oct. and Dec.

2. Schedule 'F' (Designated On-Street Pick-up/Drop-Off Spaces for the Disabled) of By-law No. 34-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by deleting the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Linsmore Crescent	East	Queensdale Avenue and a point 15.5 metres south	8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
