## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW No. 449-2013**

#### **To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 694, Signs, General, to correct minor technical errors.**

Whereas at its meeting of February 22 and 23, 2010, City Council adopted By-law No. 196-2010, which by-law enacted Chapter 694, Signs, General, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code; and

Whereas Section 694-30R(2) of Chapter 694, Signs, General, as enacted under By-law No. 196-2010, mistakenly contained the word reconsider where the remainder of Section 694-30 utilized the word consider; and

Whereas Section 694-31A of Chapter 694, Signs, General, permits a person to obtain an amendment to the provisions of the Chapter for the purpose of implementing a signage master plan to establish specific regulations concerning the location, arrangement, type and design of signs to be erected on specific premises to ensure the signs displayed are appropriate to their function and compatible with the nature of the specific premises upon which the signs are located; and

Whereas City of Toronto Council enacted By-law No. 1635-2012 on November 29, 2012, and in so doing enacted an amendment to the provisions of Chapter 694, Signs, General for the purpose of implementing a signage master plan establishing specific regulations concerning the location, arrangement, type and design of signs; and

Whereas Schedule B to Chapter 694, Signage Master Plans and Area Specific Amendments, as enacted under By-law No. 1635-2012, mistakenly contained an entry utilizing the phrase 15 years where the phrase 5 years was intended with respect to a specific location north of the boundary of Eglinton Avenue East, and approximately 150 metres east of Bellamy Road North; and

Whereas under Section 169-26 of Chapter 169, Officials, City, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to make technical amendments to The City of Toronto Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 694, Signs, General, is amended by deleting the word "reconsider" from Subsection 694-30R(2) and substituting it with the word "consider".

2. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 694, Signs, General, is amended by deleting the phrase "15 years" from Subsection 2.G.(1)(b) to Schedule B to Chapter 694, Signage Master Plans and Area Specific Amendments, and substituting the phrase "5 years" therefore.
