BY-LAW No. 777-2013

To permanently close part of the public highway known as Kirkhams Road, north of Meadowvale Road.

Whereas it is recommended that part of the public highway known as Kirkhams Road, north of Meadowvale Road be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close part of the said public highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Scarborough Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on February 14, 2012;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Part of the public highway known as Kirkhams Road, north of Meadowvale Road, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

PIN 06054-0839 (LT) Part of the South Half of Lot 5, Concession 3 Scarborough, designated as Part 7 on Plan 64R-3434.

Part of PIN 06054-0841 (LT) Part of the South Half of Lot 5, Concession 3 and part of Lot 2 on Plan 3425, designated as Parts 2 and 6 on Plan 64R-3434, Saving and Excepting part of Lot 2 on Plan 3425, designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-26627; Parts 5, 6, 9 and 15 on Plan 64R-3433; and Part 2 on Plan 66R-26627.
