CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 781-2013

To dedicate certain land on the north side of Lake Shore Boulevard West, extending easterly from Etobicoke Creek, for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard West.

Whereas the City is the owner of certain land, the Operational Management of which was transferred to Transportation Services for public highway purposes pursuant to the exercise by the Chief Corporate Officer on June 5, 2013 of delegated authority contained in EX43.17 adopted by City of Toronto Council on May 11 and 12, 2010, evidenced Property Management Committee Decision Document No. 2013-004;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Certain land described as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 07632-0037 (LT)

Part of Lot 21 on Plan 2172 and part of Lot 12, Broken Front Concession,
designated as PARTS 1, 2 and 3 on Plan 66R-26832

PIN 07632-0038 (LT)

PT LT 12, CON 1 BROKEN FRONT, CLOSED BY BR15560 AS (FIRSTLY)
IN BR15560 EXCEPT PT 17 64R9386

City of Toronto (former City of Etobicoke) and Province of Ontario

Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard West.
