BY-LAW No. 1189-2013

To amend further By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, respecting the regulation of traffic on Huntsmill Boulevard.

The Scarborough Community Council enacts:

1. Schedule X (Parking for Restricted Periods) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 From	To)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Huntsmill Boulevard	North	A point 103.5 metres east of Springhouse Square (west intersection)	A point 63.5 metres further east	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday to Friday	30 Minutes

2. Schedule XI (No Standing) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 From	To)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Huntsmill Boulevard	North	A point 17.5 metres east of Springhouse Square (west intersection)	A point 86 metres further east	Anytime
