BY-LAW No. 1193-2013

To amend further By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, respecting the regulation of traffic on Alvin Curling Crescent, Porcelain Terrace and Serenity Court.

The Scarborough Community Council enacts:

- 1.** Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Intersection)	(In Column 2 Stop Street)
Porcelain Terrace and Alvin Curling Crescent (north intersection)	Porcelain Terrace (north intersection)
Porcelain Terrace and Alvin Curling Crescent (south intersection)	Porcelain Terrace (south intersection)
Serenity Court and Alvin Curling Crescent	Serenity Court

- 2.** Schedule XX (Heavy Truck Prohibition) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 From	To)	(In Column 3 Times or Days)
Alvin Curling Crescent	Goldhawk Trail (north intersection)	Goldhawk Trail (south intersection)	Anytime
Porcelain Terrace	Alvin Curling Crescent (north intersection)	Alvin Curling Crescent (south intersection)	Anytime
Serenity Court	Alvin Curling Crescent	Southwest end of Serenity Court	Anytime
